### NEC CONFERS WITH POLITICAL PARTIES

(Monrovia/June 2, 2011)The National Elections Commission (NEC) will hold a monthly Inter-Party Consultative Committee (IPCC) meeting on Friday, June 3, 2011 at Quelu Farms and Resort in Careysburg City.

The meeting, to be chaired by the NEC Chairperson, Mr. James Fromayan, is intended to give political parties updates on events unfolding at the commission. The IPCC forum is also a space where political parties seek clarity on elections policy issues and make substantive in-puts on various electoral issues. The meeting will bring together representatives of Civil Society Organizations (CSO) international and local partners and members of the press corps.

During the June 3, 2011 meeting, the commission and political parties will review campaign finance regulation and the campaign finance forms. The forum will also be used to give updates on the impending referendum, the status of the electoral boundary district delineation and the accreditation of political parties and independent candidate agents.

The NEC's Political Liaison Officer, Joseph Yarsiah , stresses the need for political parties regularly, saying, "as the country marches towards the delineation of electoral districts and the conduct of the national referendum, the General and Presidential elections , the IPCC meetings serves as a useful forum in enhancing cordiality and fruitful rapprochement between the NEC and political parties."
