Directive to the Magistrate of Elections

Please be advised that NEC National Civic Educators and Registration Supervisors as well as members of the Liberian National Police (LNP) are to be afforded the special provisions contained in the Polling Procedures on Election Day. In order to receive special voting rights, both National Civic Educators and Registration Supervisors must produce their NEC issued identification as well as their Voter Identification Cards where they intend to vote. LNP members seeking to benefit from the special voting provisions must produce their LNP identification card as well as their Voter Identification Cards. When the Presiding Officer is satisfied an individual qualifies for the special voting provisions, s/he will determine, based on that individual's Voter Identification Number what ballots s/he will receive.

Where an individual is in the county they registered for but not in the proper district:

- The Presiding Officer will enter their particulars on the Additions to the FRR list attached to each Final Registration Roll
- They will be given a ballot for the Presidential election
- They will receive a ballot for the Senatorial election
- They *will not* receive a ballot for the House of Representatives election

Where an individual is in the district they registered for but not the proper voting precinct:

- The Presiding Officer will enter their particulars on the Additions to the FRR list attached to each Final Registration Roll
- They will be given all three ballots and allowed to vote in all three elections

Where an individual is not in the county where they registered:

- The Presiding Officer will enter their particulars on the Additions to the FRR list attached to each Final Registration Roll
- They will only receive a ballot for the Presidential election
