- 2) That the Elections Magistrate for Gbarpolu County be ordered to apply forthwith the Provision of the National Elections Commission's Tally Exception Procedures for the Election of the President, the Senate and Members of the House Representatives of the Republic of Liberia, adopted by NEC Decision No. 2005-49 on 6 October 2005, to the Senate Record of Count forms.

3) That the Elections Magistrate for Gbarpolu County be ordered to endorse and forward forthwith by the fastest means possible, a Declaration of Preliminary Tally Results for the Senate, removing and not processing any Record of the Count forms quarantined pursuant to Sections 2 and 3 (f) of said Tally Exception Procedures.
