WRIT OF ELECTIONS

TO: Mr. Washington Farmah
MAGISTRATE FOR BOMI COUNTY,
REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA

WHEREAS, I HAVE BEEN MANDATED by the Chairman of the National Elections Commission (NEC) to inform you that Presidential and Legislative Elections are to be held for President, Vice President, Senators, and Representatives of the Republic of Liberia within your County of assignment;


WHEREAS, the Presidential and Legislative Elections are to be held in accordance with Article XIX (2) of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement (CPA) which states that Elections shall be conducted not later than October, 2005; Article 83 (a) of the 1986 Liberian Constitution, which requires that Presidential and Legislative Elections shall be conducted throughout the Republic on the second Tuesday in October of each election year; the New Elections Law of 1986 and the Electoral Reform Law of 2004;

WHEREAS, Your County of assignment has been allotted three (3) electoral districts in the House of Representatives as shown on the Electoral Districting Plan attached to this Writ of Elections;

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby command you to conduct throughout your County of assignment, Presidential and Legislative Elections on the 11th day of October, A.D. 2005, between the hours of 8: 0'clock Ante Meridian to 6: 0'clock Post Meridian and that you do certify to me by endorsement upon this Writ, at the close of the counting of votes as to the form and manner you conducted the Presidential and Legislative elections of October 11, 2005, throughout your County of assignment. And for so doing, this shall constitute your legal and sufficient authority

AND I DO HEREBY DIRECT that the last day for nomination of Candidates by duly registered Political Parties and Independent Candidates shall be the 6th day of August, A.D. 2005 at 4: 0'Clock Post Meridian.
